

Insurance Self Pay Agreement

Insurance companies in Vermont cover Chiropractic care on a limited basis. All plans are different and you are responsible for knowing your own benefits.

In general, the following services are covered:

1. Treatment for acute conditions or limited flare-ups of a chronic condition.
2. Supportive care, defined as care when a member has reached maximum improvement, but fails to sustain this improvement and progressively deteriorates when treatment is withdrawn.
3. A therapeutic trial for a chronic condition if Chiropractic care has never been attempted for this condition.

The following services are typically *not* covered:

1. Treatment for a chronic condition when the therapeutic goals of the treatment plan have been achieved and no progress is apparent or expected to occur
2. Maintenance/Preventive/Wellness care, defined as care in the absence of symptoms or care to promote better health or to enhance performance in sporting activities
3. Treatment for “visceral conditions”, i.e. A condition that is not Neuromusculoskeletal in nature.
4. Treatment over the allowed number of visits per your insurance plan where an extension has not been approved.
5. Any treatment which your insurance company deems as not “medically necessary”.

Jerome Family Chiropractic, LLC will make every effort to alert you when we think services will not be covered by your insurance company, however, we cannot say definitively what is or is not covered until your insurance company has processed the claim.
